11 Nights 12 Days Kailash Mansarovar Package by Helicopter From Kathmandu

Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu

Attractions: Warm Welcome in Kathmandu

- Upon arrival at Kathmandu Airport, meet our representative for a warm welcome.
- Transfer to your premium hotel in Kathmandu.

Day 2: Kathmandu – Nepalganj or Surkhet (By Flight)

Day 5: Taklakot – Lake Mansarovar (56 km – 3 Hours, 4,590 m)

Attractions: Hor Chu & Holy Mansarovar Lake

- After breakfast, begin your journey to Lake Mansarovar via Hor Chu.
- Witness the pristine beauty and spiritual significance of the holy lake, considered sacred in both Hindu and Buddhist traditions.
- Spend time in reflection, with breathtaking views of Mount Kailash in the background.

Accommodation: Simple lodges/tents near Lake Mansarovar (on sharing basis) Meals: Breakfast, lunch & dinner Activities: Scenic views and spiritual experiences Transport: AC luxury coach (subject to weather conditions) Toilet & Shower Facility: Not available

Day 6: Lake Mansarovar – Darchen – Tarboche (Yam Dwar) – Deraphuk Gomba (88 km Parikrama + 20 km drive + 18 km trek)

Attractions: Parikrama of Mansarovar, Yam Dwar & Mount Kailash Trek

- Begin the day with a holy bath in Mansarovar Lake, followed by a ceremonial worship.
- Complete the sacred Parikrama of the lake (88 km), then drive to Darchen (20 km).
- From Yam Dwar, begin trekking to Deraphuk Gomba, enjoying awe-inspiring views of Mount Kailash.

Accommodation: Guesthouse/lodge on sharing basis in Deraphuk Meals: Breakfast, lunch & dinner Activities: Trekking & closer views of Lord Shiva's home, Mount Kailash Transport: AC luxury bus/jeep; ponies/yaks available at extra cost Toilet & Shower Facility: Not available

Day 7: Deraphuk Gomba – Zuthul Phuk Gomba (22 km – 10 Hours, 4,750 m)

Attractions: Dolma La Pass & Gauri Kund View

- Trek to Zuthul Phuk, crossing the challenging Dolma La Pass (5,500 m) before descending past the sacred Gauri Kund.
- Trekking distance: 22 km, approximately 10 hours.

Day 9: Taklakot - Hilsa - Simikot

 - **46-150 Days Prior to Departure:** 70% refund minus INR 15,000/USD 300.
 - **31-45 Days Prior to Departure:** 35% refund minus the non-refundable deposit.
 - **0-30 Days Prior to Departure:** No refund will be issued.

Important Points

• Be prepared for weather disruptions or delays. In case of changes, additional costs will need to be borne by the traveler.

4. Health Precautions:

- Acclimatization is essential at high altitudes. Follow medical advice and avoid exertion.
- Carry personal medicines for altitude sickness or any specific health conditions.

5. Spiritual Guidance:

• Keep faith in Lord Shiva for a safe and fulfilling journey. Chant "Om Namah Shivaya" for spiritual support.
